**A Resolution Censuring The Board Of Trustees Of The Charleston County School District**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Charleston County School District was created by South Carolina Act 340 of 1967 to be the governing body of the Charleston County School District, and

**WHEREAS**, the policies of the Charleston County School District state that it is the Board of Trustees' "duty to carry out the will of the community in matters of public education," and


**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Charleston County School District is responsible for hiring the Superintendent of Education of Charleston County, and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Charleston County School District launched a flawed and unfair search guided by the South Carolina School Boards Association and the Childs & Halligan Law Firm, and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Charleston County School District continued interviews with very little to no community input days after the Massacre at Mother Emanuel AME Church, and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved that the Board of Trustees of the St. James-Santee Constituent School District No. 1 of Charleston County does hereby censure the Board of Trustees of the Charleston County School District for their lack of carrying out the will of the community in Charleston County in the search process for a new Superintendent of Education of Charleston County.
